Research Story

Evaluation of Hong Kong's Trade and Economic Policies

An academic essay published in October 2019 written by Prof. Eden S H YU, Vice President (Research), and Prof. Kenneth S CHAN, Visiting Research Professor, provides a critical evaluation of Hong Kong's trade and economic policies in the recent years. They find that Hong Kong has remained by and large competitive with sound macroeconomic fundamentals and abundant fiscal surplus. Yet, several challenges have emerged recently. Internally, Hong Kong continues to suffer from deteriorating income inequality and unaffordable housing which result in social instability such as the ongoing large-scale social unrest since June 2019.

Externally, the US-China trade frictions also brought pressure to Hong Kong's economy. It is thus proposed that the Hong Kong SAR Government consider re-evaluating industrial and social policies and mobilise more resources to mitigate income inequality and promote research and development, so as to help the city to move up the technological ladder of the global value chain. The government should resort to more pro-active strategies. The article advocates expanding the Competition Commission's mission to include mispricing issues from non-pecuniary externalities originated in non-traded sectors and to capitalise opportunities brought by the development of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area along with the Belt and Road Initiative. However, the first and foremost priority is to strengthen the rule-of-law framework, which has been the key institutional comparative advantage of Hong Kong.

The article by Yu and Chan appeared in a recent special issue of *The World Economy*, an academic journal edited at the Nottingham University in the UK and published by John Wiley. On October 1, 2018, the World Trade Organization (WTO) Secretariat issued a draft of the 8th Trade Policy Review of Hong Kong. In response to the WTO Review, the Hong Kong SAR Government provided a Report on the Trade Policy Review with clarifications in October 2018. In this connection, the article offers a critical review on the Report regarding the current status of Hong Kong's economy and makes a set of policy recommendations.

Research News

Symposium on the Review of the Research Grants Council (RGC) (Phase II)

► The Working Group on the Review of RGC (Phase II), formed in 2018 by the University Grants Committee (UGC), has prepared an interim report covering observations and preliminary recommendations on the RGC's operation based on their consultant's findings. The UGC organised a symposium on the findings on 15 July 2019 (Monday) at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. A briefing on the preliminary findings and recommendations was given by Prof. Edward YEUNG, Convenor of the Working Group, and an open discussion session with the presence of the UGC Chairman, the RGC Chairman and the Convenor of the Working Group was held. The symposium enabled communication between the UGC/RGC and the research community, with face-to-face exchange of views between the funding agency and front-line researchers. Research Grants Council Workshop on Application Procedures

► The RGC organised a workshop on 7 November 2018 (Thursday) evening at Education Bureau Kowloon Tong Education Services Centre for potential applicants to enhance their understanding of the RGC's three Self-financed Funding Schemes. The RGC explained in detail the assessment process and criteria, as well as the Panel's observations on the applications in the last exercise. It also introduced new arrangements for the coming exercise (i.e. 2020/21 exercise). Subject Convenors of the Assessment Panel joined the Workshop to answer questions from the participants. Interested colleagues of our College attended the workshop. The PowerPoint presentations by selected FDS awardees and Prof. Helen MENG Mei-ling, Chairman of Assessment Panel, will be made available on the RGC's website (<https://www.ugc.edu.hk/eng/rgc/index.html>) in due course.

FDS Research Project (UGC/FDS13/H01/17) on Hong Kong Couplets

► Couplet is an important Chinese literary and cultural heritage. It is a combination of the artistry of using the Chinese language in a poetic manner and writing the Chinese characters in an aesthetic way. Hong Kong has numerous places, sites, and historic buildings which are adorned with couplets. Many of these couplets are not only well-composed by famous writers but also well-written by famous calligraphers. The ongoing two-year research project led by Prof. TANG Chiu Kay (Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences) aims to salvage this precious part of Hong Kong literature, art, and culture by recording couplets posted or inscribed on outdoor and indoor structures in Hong Kong before they disappear in the course of time. At present, a total of 3,301 couplets have been recorded. They provide valuable information on the history, culture, and anecdotes of the literary arena of Hong Kong, thus contributing to a better understanding of local history, literature, customs and behaviour of the inhabitants.

Launch of Chu Hai FOSS (free and open source software)

► The project team of QESS-funded project “Enhancing teaching and learning by effective utilization of free and open source software”*, led by Dr. LEE Kwok Fong Tracy (Department of Journalism and Communication) and Mr. DUAN Chenggui (Centre of Buddhist Studies), have recently launched the website Chu Hai FOSS (珠多網, <https://www.fossedu.hk>). The website was developed with the goal to create a user-friendly and powerful platform for our teachers and students, and eventually, the general public, to discover and search for free and open source tools that can enhance the quality of their teaching and learning experience. It covers different categories of educational tools including Classroom Interactivity, Media Editing, Learning Tools, Communication and Collaboration, Courseware Production, Resource Materials and Document Processing. It is currently open to our staff and students to enrich teaching and learning.

Activities Highlights

International Conference: “Recent Advances in International Trade, Finance and Business”

► The Conference, held on 17–18 December 2018 at the campus, was organized by the Research Center for International Business and Trade, Chu Hai College of Higher Education*, and co-organized by the International Economics and Finance Society, China, and Asian Development Bank Institute, Tokyo. Over 60 participants attended the event with keynote presentations by two distinguished speakers, Prof. Charles INGENE of University of Oklahoma, USA, and Prof. Sushanta MALLICK of Queen Mary University of London. Over 30 research papers were selected for

presentation by established researchers and younger academics from all over the world, including Australia, Canada, Korea, Japan, the UK and the USA, as well as those from the Greater China region (China Mainland, Macau and Hong Kong). Selected conference papers will be published in the SSCI journal *Economic Modelling* in 2020.

International Conference: “Greater Bay Area (Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau): Global Business, Technology and Cultural Perspectives”

► The Conference, held on 10–11 May 2019 at the campus, was jointly organized by the Research Center for International Business and Trade, Chu Hai College of Higher Education* and Hong Kong Society for Asian-Pacific 21. Two renowned speakers, Prof. CHAN Man Hung of One Belt One Road Research Institute, Chu Hai College, and Prof. Naoyuki YOSHINO of Asian Development Bank Institute in Tokyo, delivered the keynote speeches. More than 20 research papers were

presented by prominent academics and young researchers from all over the world, including Canada, Japan, Malaysia, Vietnam, China Mainland, Macau and Hong Kong.

蔡元培先生為近代中國重要的思想家與教育家，其治學精神、教育理念、為人風骨，均為當代知識份子之典範。昔日蔡元培先生致力將北大發揚成為五四時期新文化運動核心基地，並一手創建中央研究院，成為全球知名的學術重鎮。其所倡議以「科學」、「民主」為軸心之大學精神，至今仍被教育與學術界奉為圭臬。今年適逢蔡元培先生一百五十周年冥誕，珠海學院亞洲研究中心聯合中研院近代

史研究所、政治大學人文中心、北京大學歷史系及珠海學院中國文學系共同舉辦「蔡元培與近代中國」學術研討會。會議於 2018 年 12 月 8 至 9 日在珠海學院舉行，獲蔡元培先生之子蔡英多先生及孫女蔡磊珂女士擔任開幕嘉賓，由珠海學院校長李焯芬教授致開幕詞；副校長俞肇熊教授致歡迎詞，來自兩岸三地的學者發表約二十篇論文，並安排嘉賓至饒宗頤文化館參觀「蔡元培與北京大學」主題展覽。

移民與城市文化：2019 年海外華人研究學術研討會

珠海學院亞洲研究中心與海外華人研究學會、臺灣師範大學東亞學系、日本德山大學、香港亞太二十一學會、城市智庫及大中華區管理學人協會聯合舉辦「移民與城市文化：2019 年海外華人研究學術研討會」。此會議以跨學科的視角，探索在時間、空間與各種相涉的理論層面中，全球海外華人移民與社群流動不同的學術內涵及意義。會議於 2019 年 7 月 11 至 12 日在珠海學院舉行，由珠海學院校

長李焯芬教授、珠海學院文學與社會科學院院長兼亞洲研究中心總監鄧昭祺教授，及海外華人研究學會理事長李盈慧教授致開幕詞。

李盈慧教授並與日本德山大學紙矢健治教授、臺灣大學姜蘭虹教授及大中華區管理學人協會會長鄧木佳博士發表了專題演講，會上亦進行了四場討論會，學者和研究生發表共二十多篇論文。

Visit to South China Normal University (SCNU)

Chu Hai FOSS* organised a half-day visit to South China Normal University (SCNU) on 27 November 2018 and dozens of our students and teachers joined the activity. They attended two workshops organised by the School of Information Technology in Education, SCNU, delivered by Prof. LIU Jing (劉競), Head of Department of Journalism and Communication, on how new technology impacts journalism education, and by Prof. MU Su (穆肅), Head of Department of the Information Technology in Education, on how information technology can be used to collect data and how it can impact policymaking.

Our students and teachers visited the television studio, VR studio and editing studio of the Department of Journalism and Communication. They were deeply impressed by the new e-learning classrooms during the campus tour.

Back to Earth Construction Workshop - Making Creative Children's Furniture Using Construction Waste Material

Department of Architecture organized the International Design Programme 2018 on Back to Earth Construction Workshop with a theme of "Making Creative Children's Furniture Using Construction Waste Material" during 12-19 November 2018.

Participating universities include Universiteit Hasselt, Belgium, Singapore University of Design and Technology, Victoria University of Wellington, New Zealand, and National Cheng Kung University, Taiwan. The construction industry is the largest polluter that

leads to immense resource extraction, creation of harmful emissions and waste throughout the construction, operation and demolition stages. This project aims at educating future architects on how construction waste can be reused in creative ways such as adopting upcycling approaches and cradle-to-cradle concepts, and how to reduce construction waste during the construction process.

This programme was run as a live construction workshop for architecture students at Chu Hai College of Higher Education and students from National Cheng-

Kung University, Taiwan, and was guided by local and overseas digital fabrication expert instructors representing four institutions. In order to raise environmental and social sustainability awareness, students were required to make furniture for primary-school-age children of underprivileged families living in Kwai Chung. The final children furniture, manufactured by the Department, was donated to children of ethnic minority families with the help of HKSKH Lady McLehose Centre, Paul Y. Engineering volunteer team and our staff and students in Kwai Chung in June 2019.

► Research Services Office

Research Services Office (RSO, formerly Research Office) was set up in 2016 to help improve research administration.

In addition to the day-to-day support and monitoring of project administration and research budget management, RSO provides administrative support to the Research Committee, especially in relation to establishing the research infrastructure, developing policies and procedures to support research, coordination of research grant applications, dissemination of grant application information, seeking external peer review, internal and external vetting of research proposals, and maintaining a database for research information, etc.

Currently, RSO administrates the following internal funds and grants which support research and scholarly activities:

1. Seed Fund for Research – to support individual colleagues as a start-up fund to conduct smaller-scale research, and to better prepare for external grant application
2. Conference Grant – to support individual colleagues to attend international conferences for paper presentation
3. Research Publication Fund – to support individual colleagues on journal submissions or editing/ language polishing for journal papers
4.
