Research Story

On IT Technology and Healthcare

Dr. FU Hong, Department of Computer Science

"We believe that technology can bring huge changes to our daily life. It can help us to discover early diseases of children using a simpler, faster and more economical method", said Dr. FU Hong. Dr. FU, Prof. LO Wai Lun and their team have been working on early diagnoses of developmental problems for children for quite some time, using advanced IT. Their research has been supported by four FDS projects over the past few years.

I. Eye Tracking System for Strabismus Diagnosis (2014)




Figure 1 Eye tracking system for strabismus diagnosis

An eye-tracking aided strabismus diagnosis system was proposed in this project as shown in Fig.1. Subjects are asked

to gaze at target points shown on a screen. A diagnosis result is finally made according to the features extracted from gaze points captured by an eye tracker mounted below the screen.

II. Digitalized Assessment of DCD (2016)




Figure 2 A marker-less digitalized system for DCD assessment

In this project, a marker-less digitalized system was developed to measure both eye movement and body motion for DCD assessment as shown in Fig.2. The patterns and correlations of eye-motion tracking data are analyzed for visual-motor behavior in DCD assessment.

III. Intelligent Assessment of Strabismus (2017)




Figure 3 Intelligent assessment system of strabismus

An intelligent assessment system of strabismus was developed in this project as shown in Fig.3. The subject just needs to sit and stare at the target for almost forty seconds, then the video is fed into a diagnosis algorithm and a report is generated automatically containing the presence, type, angle, mobility of strabismus.

IV. Intelligent Assessment of ADHD (2018)




Figure 4 Intelligent assessment system of ADHD

This project is for ADHD assessment and the proposed system is shown in Fig.4. The subject wearing a head-mounted eye-tracker is writing on the digitalized tablet with two cameras in front. A fine eye tracking algorithm will be proposed to capture the subtle eye movements when writing the strokes.

Build up your own research portfolio

Vital for successful application for research funding

Prof. LO Wai Lun, Department of Computer Science

As academic research is part of the long-term development for academic staff, I would suggest that colleagues should first build up their own research portfolios. According to my experience, panel members of a research funding agency will assess the submitted proposals based on the following:

- Scholarly merit of the proposal and its relevance to the needs of Hong Kong
- Research outcomes and its impact with potential for applications
- Reasonable and appropriate project duration
- The track records of PI and Co-I in the research field and their ability to undertake the project

To build up your research portfolio, you should first select your own research area and form a good research team, if applicable. I would suggest that young researchers consider to join one of our College research centres and learn from other experts. Throughout the research activities, you can also build up your own publication list. You can first try to publish papers in international conferences and then try to submit papers to some international refereed journals.

However, young researchers should be prepared for rejections of their submitted papers by international journals. It is well known that journals with high impact factor generally have a quite low acceptance rates. You can start as a co-author of some papers first and then attempt to be the first author after you get some experience in research. Young colleagues can try to cooperate with the experts in local UGC-funded universities because they have abundant facilities, resources and knowhow. You can learn a lot from them.

Secondly, you can also attempt to apply for research funding from different funding sources such as QESS and ITF. You can also start your research activities with support from our College seed funding. You need to build up a solid list of research outputs in which you can be either a Co-investigator or the Principal Investigator. A good research track record is very crucial for research funding applications.

Before preparing your proposal, particularly in the field of Science and Engineering, you should assemble a good research team by inviting experts from other local or overseas universities. These scholars have solid track records and experience in getting RGC

funding or similar grants. This can increase your chances of success in the application.

You can get access plenty of tips from various sources on preparing the proposal from literature survey to writing the abstract and other parts of the proposal. Young researchers can consult the senior staff in our College for advice on preparing proposals. Finally, I wish to stress that the assessment and selection for RGC research funding and other similar schemes are very competitive. Please don't give up even if you fail several times. Your persistence and experience will lead you to eventual success.

Activity Highlights

Research Grants Council (RGC) Workshop on Application Procedures

► The RGC organised a workshop on 16 November 2018 (Friday) evening at PolyU West Kowloon Campus for potential applicants to enhance their understanding of the RGC's three Self-financed Funding Schemes. The RGC explained in detail the application guidelines, assessment procedure, criteria and Panel's feedback. It also introduced the new

Collaborative Research Grant under the Institutional Development Scheme (IDS) in the coming exercise (i.e. 2019/20 exercise). Several interested colleagues attended the workshop. The powerpoints, presented by the selected FDS awardees and Prof. Helen MENG Mei-ling, Chairman of Assessment Panel, will be available on the RGC's website in due course.

Sustainable Systems and Technologies Research Centre


► Sustainable Systems and Technologies Research Centre (SSTRC) was established in July, 2017. The SSTRC focuses on interdisciplinary research on sustainable and innovative technology, integrating and combining the three research domains, namely architecture, civil engineering and computer science. The following seminars have been held at the Research Centre in 2018.

► Research Seminar on 25 Jan 2018

Temporal action localization: given a long untrimmed video, when does a specific action start and end? This is a challenging topic because algorithms must reason not only about whether an action occurs somewhere in a video, but also on the temporal extent of when it occurs. This workshop gave an introduction to this topic. In addition, one representative paper (2016 CVPR) entitled “End-to-end Learning of Action Detection from Frame Glimpses in Videos” was shared. This paper proposed a fully end-to-end approach for action detection in videos that learns to directly predict the temporal bounds of actions. The principle and content of this method were explained in detail.

Research Seminar on 18 May 2018



Dr. FU introduced the current research projects in the Department of Computer Science, including eye tracking aided strabismus investigation, eye-motion based Developmental Coordination Disorder study, as well as automated strabismus tests. Furthermore, the Research Assistant of department of Computer Science, Mr. ZHENG Yang shared his research experience in eye detection and tracking algorithms.

Development of Virtual Reality Teaching Tools for Science and Engineering Education (25 May 2018)

Research and development in virtual reality methodology have attracted attention from computer science researchers and professionals in industrial sectors. Research outcomes in VR research have found many practical applications such as VR product design, interior design, engineering evaluation, game development and



animation. The application of virtual reality in education is relatively new to the tertiary education sector. We foresee the potential of applications of the VR teaching methods in various courses of the faculty of Science and Engineering. The major aim of this QESS project (01/QESS/2017) is to design and implement new Virtual Reality (VR) teaching tools system for improving teaching quality. In this seminar, Prof. LO shared his experience of how the project team handled the design problems, the current progress, and the future work under the project.
